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Research interests

My research career focuses on the field of Romance syntax and its connections to semantics, and pragmatics. My 2000 PhD thesis (“The syntax of sentence periphery”, revised and published as Villalba 2009) raised a principled analysis of left and right dislocation according to Kayne’s (2004) Linear Correspondence Axiom, arguing that right-dislocates were placed in a lower Topic Phrase, just above the VP, in contrast with left-dislocates, which were placed in a higher Topic Phrase in the left periphery of sentence. In Espinal & Villalba (2015) we offered strong empirical support for a model of grammar in which syntactic structures are mapped into information structures, which will feed both logical form and PF interfaces. Moreover, the role of information structure in anaphoric relations was studied in Brunetti et al. (2020), where we showed that right-dislocation has a wider set of discourse functions than previously assumed in the literature, which was confirmed experimentally from its interaction with bridging phenomena. Besides the research output, I have published a book (*El orden de palabras en contraste*, Arco, 2009) and two chapters (La estructura informativa. En la interfaz entre la sintaxis y la semántica. In *La estructura informativa*, Visor, 2021; and Modality and Information Structure: Focus, Dislocation, Interrogative and Exclamatory Sentences. In *Manual of Catalan Linguistics*, De Gruyter, 2020) addressed to a wider audience.

My second line of research focuses on exclamative sentences. In Villalba (2007), I argued for a multilevel analysis of the semantics of degree wh-exclamatives, based on experimental data. This study found a recent continuation in Trotzke & Villalba (2020, 2021b), where we offer a comparison between Catalan and German that-exclamatives from an experimental pragmatics perspective, and in Villalba (2024), where I offer an analysis of exclamation speech acts on a commitment-based framework, with new experimental data and important consequences for our knowledge of the contribution of exclamations to the common ground. Besides this research outcomes, I have also published two reference chapters addressed to a wider audience: Villalba (2023) in a collective volume, and the chapter *Exclamatives, imperatives, optatives* in the *Manual of Romance Morphosyntax and Syntax* (de Gruyter, 2017).

Finally, I am pursuing a new line of research on the functional architecture of sentence and its relation to semantics and modality on the one hand, and discourse and expressive meaning on the other. In Villalba (2019a), I argue for the crucial role of semantic selection in the articulation of the left periphery of relative and interrogative nonfinite sentences, an issue that I pursued in a recent article (Villalba, 2022), where I discuss the nature of prepositional complementizers and their connection with the modal interpretation of infinitival relative clauses. As for the encoding of discourse and expressive meaning at the left periphery of sentence, I have collaborated with Drs. M.T. Espinal and C. Real-Puigdollers in the analysis of Spanish discourse marker *vaya*, which encodes different expressive meanings by the speaker. In Espinal, Real-Puigdollers, & Villalba (2022), we consider its evolution from a verbal form to an epistemic discourse marker, and in an article in press at *Journal of Historical Syntax*, we show a further development whereby it becomes a commitment marker, formally encoding a VERUM operator. Finally, in a submitted paper to *Journal of Pragmatics* (Romance exclamative particles at the syntax-pragmatics interface: A compositional approach to exclamation) and a recent presentation at Going Romance (Nijmegen, 2023), I analyze the semantic and pragmatic roles of exclamative markers and their position in the left periphery of sentence in Romance languages. Part of this research also appears in the reference chapter “Marcadores de discurso deverbales” in *Sintaxis Histórica del Español. Cuarta parte* (Fondo de Cultura Económica/UNAM, in press).

Description

In this talk I will describe the set of Catalan expressive modifiers, which provide a subjective assessment of the speaker that does not affect the truth conditions of the sentence, namely expressive meaning. The expressive value of these elements can be encoded in pure expressive intensifiers, such as *fotut -da* 'fucking' or *punyeter -a* 'fucking', which lack descriptive meaning, and mixed expressive intensifiers, such as *maleït -ida* 'damn', which together with the expressive meaning, still convey some descriptive meaning. I will show that the shift from mixed to pure intensifiers is taking place at different paces for different items, with clear syntactic consequences.

Finally, I will show that descriptive and normative reference works have not been

particularly generous in the treatment of expressive modifiers, which is a very unfortunate situation, for they are an especially important part of the creation of expressions connoted in colloquial Catalan. Hence, a careful description of these forms can be useful in the task of recovering a Catalan colloquial register which is both genuine and lively.

Some constructions in Catalan and Spanish have repeatedly presented empirical and theoretical problems for grammatical analysis, the reason being that they appear to be at the boundary between what is the faculty of language proper and the external systems (i.e. intentional-conceptual systems or articulatory-perceptual systems). Among these constructions the following should be mentioned: idioms, intensive-modalized structures, presentational impersonal structures, constructions that include anaphoric reference to sentences or abstract entities, structures containing light verbs, contractions and allomorphies, as well as constructions containing constituents that directly affect discourse interpretation. All of them are the object of our research in this coordinated project. In order to properly articulate different linguistic domains, we intend to characterize the primitive concept of grammatical feature and analyze its function at the different grammatical levels. We will study which types of instructions linguistic features must provide to implement grammatical operations resulting in the phonetic and/or semantic interpretation of the relevant constructions, as well as their function as connective elements between the levels of grammar and the systems external to them. Different types of features will be identified, as well as the values they can take and the hierarchy in which they are articulated in order to characterize the grammatical phenomena mentioned above.

The contrastive study of three domains of sentence structure constitutes the subproject "Microvariation in the sentential architectures" (MICROARO). Assuming that linguistic variation is determined by the properties of the functional categories and, in particular, by the properties of the features that conform them, we will undertake the study of those formal objects from an informational and processing perspective in relation to: the structure of determiners, the architecture of left periphery and its relation to discourse (focus, theme), the order of arguments and modifiers (adverbs and adjectives), the selection of temporality, aspect and voice, as well as its influence in adjunct predications, passive sentence and attributive clauses. Finally, we aim at studying the relation between the syntax of the clause and the lexical syntax, and we will attempt to determine which kind of lexical elements tend to be more likely to grammaticalize in the history of the Romance languages.
